

Sacred Heart College (Autonomous)

Sacred Heart College is one of the top-ranking Arts and Science colleges in India, offering a wide variety of UG, PG and Research Programmes. Established in 1944 under the University of Madras, the college has since then shifted its affiliation to MG University, Kottayam. The College offers a variety of conventional and vocational programmes for a diverse mix of students from urban, semi urban and rural milieu. From its modest origin with 246 students in 1944, the college has grown to the present strength of over 3400 students (with 63% girls), across 22 UG, 20 PG programmes and 6 research centres. The number of permanent aided teachers with PhDs now stands at 45 out of 90. In 2004 the College was chosen as College with Potential for Excellence in 2004 by the UGC; the status was extended in 2010. In NIRF ranking too, the college has maintained its position among the top 40-75 in the country. In 2014, the college was granted Autonomous Status by the UGC and the state government and it has proven its credentials by demonstrating dynamism and rigor in academics and administration.

Department of Management Studies

The Department of Management Studies offers two honours programmes - BBA (Integrated Marketing & New Media) and BBA (Business Analytics) that are rising in popularity among students who want to make a career in management. These programmes enable students to acquire knowledge and practical aspects skills in both Business and in allied disciplines. The small class sizes allow close interaction with faculty members which help students gain the intellectual stimulus and aquisition of knowledge and skill in their selected domain


